

Let's Play!

To play you will have one person who will set out all of the pieces however they want on the table. The person who is going to **actively** play the game will then come into the room and get to look at the items for a **set amount of time**. I suggest starting at a **minute** the first round and then **adjusting the time as needed**. At the end of the time, the person running the game will **place the blanket over the items** so that they cannot be seen. The person playing the game will attempt to **list out all of the items that they saw**.



Alternative Play:

If listing out the items sounds **too easy**, try this method. At the end of the time have the person playing the game **leave the room**. The person running the game will then take all items and **place them into a basket and set it to the side**. The person playing will then need to come back and **try to correctly place all of the items back on the table**. At the end of the time, the person running the game will **place the blanket over the items** so that they cannot be seen. The person playing the game will attempt to **list out all of the items that they saw**.



Challenge:

To continue to make this game more **challenging** you can **keep adding items** or start requiring **more detail** about exactly what items they saw before they were covered.
