



Hello everyone! **Welcome to Operation: Let's Play.** I hope you are ready to laugh and play with us this week as we show you how to create your very own **Pictionary!** This is a fun game that will test your **drawing skills** and your ability to **interpret what others are trying to draw.** This is a game that requires a few people so it's great for a **family time** or with **your friends.** **Let's Play!**

Materials

- ▶ Something to draw on like a piece of paper or a white board
- ▶ Something to draw with a marker or dry erase marker
- ▶ 3" X 5" cards or other paper to write on
- ▶ A 1-minute timer

Set-Up

To set this game up you will need to start by making **several note cards** that will tell you what you are trying to **draw** to get the rest of your team to **guess.** These cards need to have **two things** written on them. They need to have a **category** and then the **item** that you will be attempting to draw. For example, if you were to make a note card with the category of **Animal** written on it you could have a **dog or cat** as the item. If you had the category of **Object** you might write down a **chair or T-shirt.**

Categories you could use:

- ▶ Animal
- ▶ Object
- ▶ Action
- ▶ Place
- ▶ People

Let's Play!

To play you will need to **divide** your group into two teams and decide what score you will be playing too. Then one person on your team will **pick a note card** from the top of the draw pile. They will get **10 seconds** to look at it and think about what they want to draw. The drawer will then **announce the category** to their team and have **1-minute to draw** to get their teammates to **guess what is on their note card**. While drawing they **cannot** write letters or numbers or speak to their team. If their team guess **correctly**, they receive a point. If they do not get it then the other team gets a **few seconds** to make a guess to claim the point. After this it is the next teams turn to choose a drawer and give it a go.



Challenges:

- ▶ This game can be played with only **one team** with a group looking to have fun with the experience.
- ▶ You can continue to make this game harder by coming up with **harder note cards** to play with.
